2009/2010 - ROHS Band Fee Descriptions

- **Uniform Cleaning Fee:** The Band Organization has all Marching Uniforms cleaned during Marching Season. This is required to ensure that the uniforms are maintained to a standard. It also saves the student/parents from having to worry about getting the uniform to the cleaners and picked up for game day.
- **Activity Fee:** The activity fee covers game and contest drinks and snacks as well as other ancillary items that are provided to all students.
- **Away Meals:** Due to the time constraints for leaving the school for away game performances, the Booster Organization picks up the meals and the students are fed once they arrive at the visiting facility. If your child has any special dietary requirements, please let us know so that we may make necessary accommodations for the proper meal for your child.
- **Polo Shirt:** This is the “Official” Band polo shirt to be worn at performances that do not require the Marching Uniform. It is worn with Khaki shorts (to be purchased by student).
- **Shoes:** These are the “Official” shoes to be worn during Marching Performances.
- **Show Shirt:** This is a Themed T-Shirt signifying the Marching program theme to be worn at times as directed by the Band Directors. The Theme changes each year.
- **Extra Show Shirts:** Extra Show shirts may be purchased for family members or friends to wear to show their support of the Band.
- **Home Meals:** While away game meals are mandatory, home game meals are an option. You may pay for your child to eat the provided meals for all home games or you may choose for your child to bring their own food to eat or for them to eat before they are to report for the game. A limited number of additional meals can be ordered the week of the game so if the student decides that they want to eat the “Band Meal” they may pay for it at the beginning of the game week.
- **Band Booster Membership (per Family):** Being a member of the Band Boosters is not required for your child to participate. We do encourage families to join and participate to help support the vast number of things that our Booster Organization does for the Band.
- **Instrument Rental Fee:** Is only required for students that use a school owned instrument.
- **Donation in lieu of Fundraising:** Is for students that choose to make a donation in lieu of participating in Fund Raising activities.
