SCHEDULE

* *eat a good healthy breakfast before coming!*

- 8:00 a.m. pit/equipment crew arrive, begin setting up instruments and equipment
8:15 a.m. Call time for rest of band/guard
* arrive in band shorts, show shirt, and black shoes/socks, and black gloves (as before)
8:30 a.m. warm-up and light rehearsal on field
9:45 a.m. finish rehearsal; load equipment truck; into uniforms
10:15 a.m. inspection / traditions
10:45 a.m. depart Red Oak HS (late morning snack from boosters on the way)
11:15 a.m. arrive at Midlothian stadium
11:45 p.m. move to warm-up
12:00 p.m. official warm-up time
12:30 p.m. move
12:45 p.m. UIL PERFORMANCE
1:00 p.m. finish, load equipment, few minutes for water, patches, etc.
1:45 p.m. depart Midlothian for Waxahachie
2:00 p.m. lunch in Waxahachie at Ryan's (* bring \$8.00 for this meal – ahead of time or in the morning)
3:45 p.m. approximate arrival back in Red Oak

- At UIL we don't compete against other bands, we perform for an evaluative rating. There are only 3 judges, and they are not assigned separate categories of music and marching—each judge rates everything they see and hear. Each judge assigns a rating, with “I” being the highest (superior) rating. It takes 2 of the 3 judges assigned a “I” for the band to receive a composite 1st Division rating. (although we would, of course, prefer ones from all three judges!) To advance to AREA we have to make a 1 on this day at Region.
- Parents, this is a free event – no admission charge. Please try and get off work for a little bit and come support us! Loud and proud!! (all students will attend the UIL marching contest)
- Money to bring:
 - a. Optional: UIL “First Division” patches should be available (after earned)...usually around \$5 or less
 - b. \$8.00 for lunch at Ryan's (please bring exact amount – it will be collected from you at some point in the morning, or you can bring it the day before on Tuesday)
